

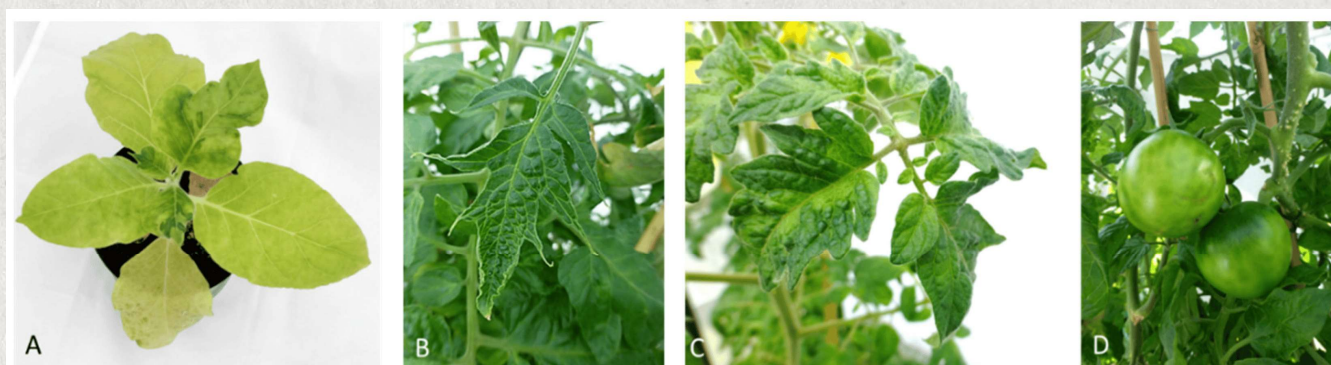
## To be seen or not to be seen: Latent infection by *tobamoviruses*



*Tobamovirus*, Latent infection, Symptoms, Diagnosis

This review looks at the group of *Tobamoviruses* to which tomato brown rugose fruit virus belongs.

Some *Tobamoviruses* cause latent infection in their hosts, which means that no obvious symptoms are visible. This has implications of diagnostics as multiple infections with latent and non-latent viruses may only focus on the symptom-inducing viruses. Furthermore, latent viruses may affect symptomology or replication of co-infecting viruses which may lead to more severe symptoms on host plants.
